



CONVOY PROCEDURES

The Club has the following rules in place for when we are traveling in convoy. It is every trip participant's responsibility to adhere to them.

1. Trip Leader to call convoy group meeting prior to start and remind members of convoy procedure.
2. Observe road rules at all times.
3. All vehicles are responsible for the vehicle behind at all times. They must always wait at all intersections and cross roads as so the car behind does not get lost.
4. Leader to appoint "tail end Charlie" vehicle for each trip.
5. Vehicles leaving convoy procedure for any reason, must inform the trip leader and "tail end Charlie" of their intention.
6. No vehicle to pass leader, unless in an emergency.
7. Keep a safe distance from the vehicle in front at all times especially when in hilly country or when brakes are wet.
8. Allow vehicle in front to get over crest of hill before you attempt to follow. If you get stuck, get out and stop the vehicle from following you or notify over the CB radio.
9. Lead vehicle to carry a flag on hill track where possible.
10. The Trip Leader may nominate another person (track marshal) to oversee the traffic on areas he/she considers blind or dangerous.
11. In the event of a winch being used, the winch operator will automatically become track marshal.
12. Vehicles in the Club that carry emergency equipment or personnel will be classified as emergency vehicles and must be given clear passage.
13. In the event of an accident or mishap on a trip, all non-emergency vehicles will leave the immediate area of the accident.

These convoy procedures are in place for your safety and convenience and are for everyone to observe
